This document will help you understand how Bookworm Cybersecurity uses and protects the data you provide to us when you participate in our demonstration.

What User Data We Observe

None of the data we observe throughout the demonstration is kept or retained; all information is destroyed at the conclusion of the demonstration.

When you participate in the demonstration, we observe the following data:

- Your IP address
- Packet metadata your device sends and receives through our network

What User Data We Don't Observe

- The specific contents of your internet traffic and use

What This Means To You

When you participate in the demonstration, we only observe what you are doing, not any specifics more than that. Meaning, we can see if you send and receive email, or browse the web, but we do not observe contents of emails or specific webpages accessed.

Why We Do This

- To show you how your data can be compromised when using networks that are not your own, instead of just telling you
- To provide a real example of how this works, live, and right in front of you
- To educate and provide a memorable experience that you will think about whenever using a network other than your own
- To make you more conscious of the risks of network use, and overall teach habits to keep you safer
